

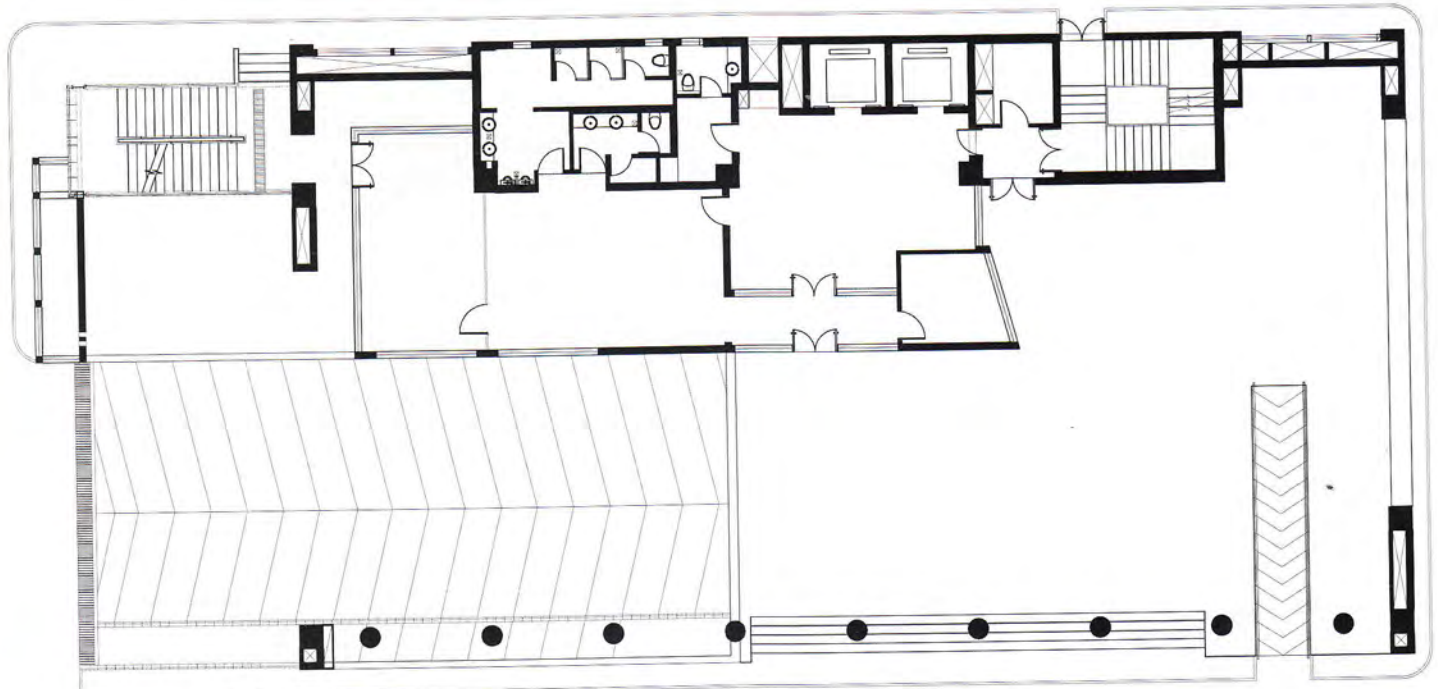
Spatial Sculpting

Architects: Morphogenesis, New Delhi/Bengaluru

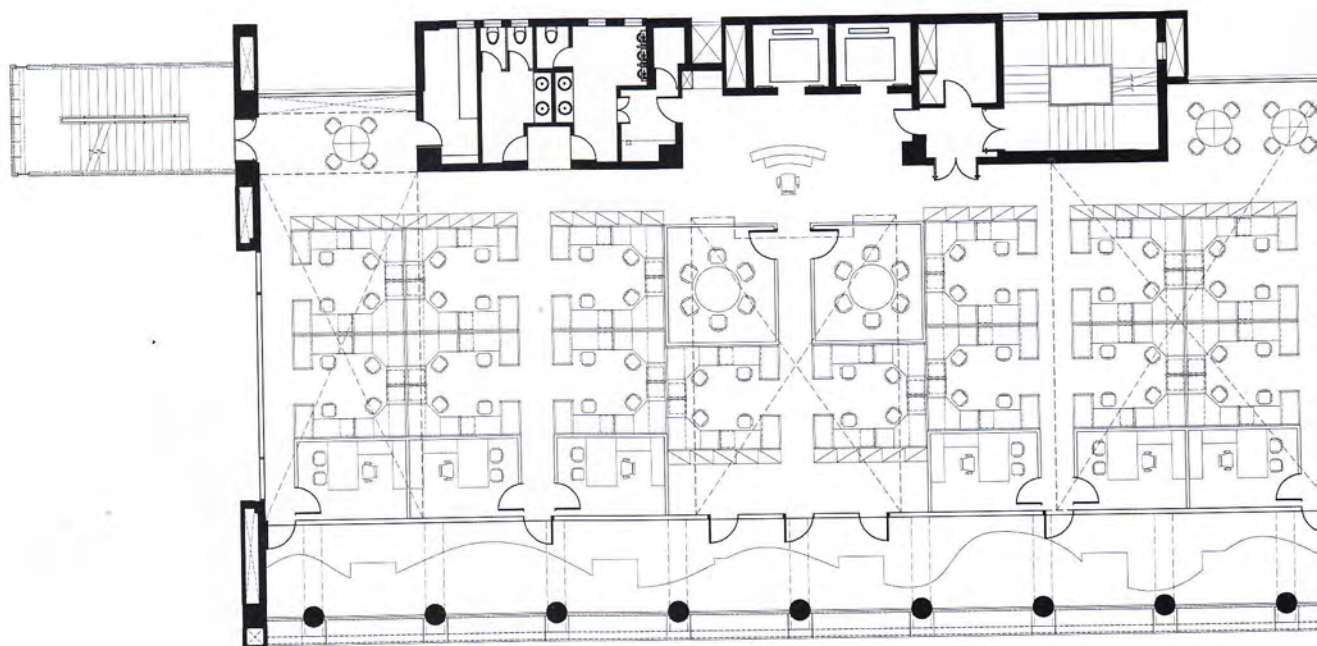
The office was designed with the intent of creating a clean and minimalist, no-fuss office space which would be representative of the work ethos of the construction firm. The site was extremely tight and the main objective was to bring in the green into the working space. A linear core was created along the western façade, to act as a thermal buffer and protect the working spaces from the extreme environmental conditions. The building was conceived as a solid from which internal volumes were carved out. Spatial sculpting was the predominant theme; the floor plate shifted as one went up, to create voids and terraces on every floor and an atrium in the front wrapped around the shell. This also enabled interconnected sectional fluidity which provided a sense of openness and the daylight
